Game Day Events, Oct. 9th

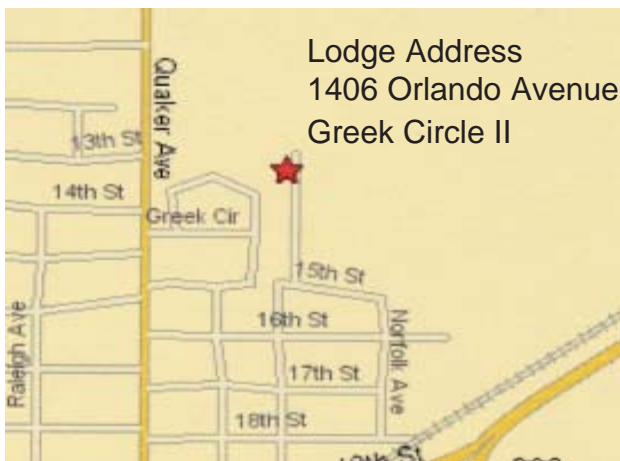
